RULES OF CONDUCT & DISCIPLINE

1. All students should conduct themselves with DECENCY, DECORUM and DIGNITY at all time and in all places.
2. Students must co-operate in protecting and taking care of all college properties and equipments. They are expected to keep the building, playfields and their rooms neat and tidy.
3. Students who want to participate in matches and competitions which are not conducted by the college, can do so only after getting the permission of the Principal.
4. Students who are found damaging college property will be expelled from the college. If any damage to the college property is caused by the student who is not identified, a minimum fine of Rs.100/- per student will be levied at the end of the year.
5. The following rules shall be on force in the college as per the Tamilnadu Educational rules
 - a) A student who has been convicted of any offence in a criminal court will not be allowed to continue his/her studies in the college.
 - b) Students should abstain from active participation in party or communal politics.
 - c) Students who indulge in political propaganda or who organize fellow students into political factions in the premises of the college or who otherwise engage themselves in party are liable to be expelled from the college.
 - d) Principal or other constituted college authorities may frame and issue from time to time disciplinary rules of a permanent or temporary nature relating to the conduct, inside and outside the college premises, of students.
 - e) Principal and other constituted college authorities shall have full powers to inflict the following punishments in the interest of the students or of the institution concerned fine, denial of attendance, denial of term certificates, suspension and expulsion.

RAGGING

Ragging is strictly forbidden within or outside the educational institution.

Tamilnadu Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1997

Definition

In this Act unless the context otherwise requires, "ragging" means display a noisy, disorderly conduct, doing any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution and includes

- a) Teasing, abusing by playing practical jokes on, or causing hurt to such student or
- b) Asking the student to do any act or perform something which such students will not in the ordinary course willingly do

Penalty of Ragging

Whenever directly or indirectly students commit, participate on abets or propagates "ragging" within or outside the educational institution, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

Dismissal of student

Without prejudice to the forgoing provisions, whenever any student complaints of ragging to the Head of the Educational institution, or any other person responsible for the management of the educational institutions he/she shall inquire into the matter immediately and if found true shall dismiss the student, who has committed the offence, from the educational institution.

The decision by the Head of the Educational institution or the person responsible for the management of the educational institution regarding any students who indulged in ragging under sub-section (1) shall be final.

Rules regarding Attendance & Leave of Absence

1. No College shall conduct the Semester Examinations or present the students to the Semester Examinations without the criteria of ninety working days.
2. A candidate requires seventy five percent of attendance to qualify for admission to any prescribed Examination of the University.
3. If a student is absent for one or more hours during a session (F.N. or A.N.) he/she will lose the attendance for half-a-day.
4. The principal of a college shall have a power to condone shortage of attendance of students to be admitted for University Examinations upto a maximum of a 10 percent, i.e., nine days each semester on valid reasons as ill health etc., on payment of the prescribed condonation fee of Rs.400/-
5. Statement of attendance of the students shall be displayed in the college notice board every month.
6. In case the shortage of attendance of a student exceeds the limit prescribed for the purpose of condonation of attendance, he/she will not be allowed to the University Examinations.

7. A student will be given only one opportunity to carry forward the deficiency in attendance of one semester to the next semester during the degree course, failing which he/she will have to re-do the course.

Library Rules

- ✓ It is mandatory on the part of all students of the college to be the members of the college Library.
- ✓ On all working days the library will be kept open from 10 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.
- ✓ The Library will be closed on Holidays.
- ✓ Strict silence should be maintained inside the Library.
- ✓ Before entering the library students will have to deposit their personal belongings at the personal property desk.
- ✓ Loud consultation, animated conversation etc. are strictly prohibited.
- ✓ The borrower will be held responsible for any damage done by him/her to the books and other properties belonging to the library.
- ✓ Reference books must be referred in the library itself. No book should be taken out of the Library.
- ✓ Any marking, underlining, clipping or annotating of book is absolutely forbidden.
- ✓ No Student is allowed to sub-lend library books.
- ✓ Before leaving the counter the student shall satisfy himself as to whether the books lent to him/her are in good condition and if they are not, he/she shall immediately bring the matter to the notice of the librarian, otherwise the last borrower will be held responsible for any book in damaged condition and shall replace the book or pay compensation as may be fixed by the librarian.
- ✓ All books borrowed shall be returned to Library by the due date failing which overdue charge of Re.1 per day will be collected.
- ✓ Transfer Certificate or Conduct Certificate will not be issued to the student unless he/she returns the books and pay dues, if any.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The following Scholarships are available to the students.

1. Government of India Scholarship

Students belonging to the scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes are eligible to apply for the awards of the Scholarships, if the annual income of their parents does not exceed Rs.1,00,000/-

2. Harijan Welfare Scholarship under State Scheme

The students belonging to Adi Dravida converts are eligible to apply for the Harijan Welfare State Scholarship provided their parental income does not exceed Rs.50,000/- per annum.

Note

Scheduled caste, Scheduled tribes class students who intend to apply for scholarships should maintain 90% attendance throughout the year.

Placement and Training Cell

Placement and Training Cell of our college was set up during the academic year 2006-2007. This cell facilitates the students to train and motivate themselves for higher studies like IAS, MBA, MCA and Bank Examinations. Various companies are invited for Campus interview for final year students.

The main aim of the Cell is to guide UG and PG students to get an awareness of their future in the competitive world and to get placement in reputed companies.

Examinations Rules and Regulations for Students:

Students will not be allowed into the examinations hall without presenting an appropriate photo identity card, issued by the institution.

The students will not be allowed to appear in the examination, if they reach the examination centre after 15 minutes from the start of minor examinations and 30 minutes from start of major examinations.

The students must ensure that the attendance sheet should be signed before starting the examination.

The students should not bring the following items into the exam hall: Pencil cases, mobile phones, dictionaries, written or electronic media, electronic devices, any other materials are not permitted / allowed into the examinations hall, with the exceptions of devices used for assisting students with hearing, visual or physical difficulties.

Students should bring their own pencils, pens, erasers, rulers, calculators, and any other tools required for the examinations. Exchange of pens, pencils, calculators, etc. is not permitted.

The students not allowed to bring any eatable item inside the examination hall.

During the examinations period, there must be no communications among students or between a students and an outsider via any mean, such as phones.

The person with disabilities and other medical problems will be provided scribe in the examinations, only subject to prior permission.

No student is allowed to leave the hall time (Major Examinations) and 30 minutes (minor examinations) after the start of the examination.

If a student falls ill during the examination and is unable to complete the examination, the concerned student should alert the invigilator and HOD's may make suitable arrangement may be made for proper medical attention.

No student shall re-enter the examination hall after leaving it unless he/she was under approved supervision during the full period of absence.
